# <u>Indices of Deprivation 2015 for Lower Super Output Areas in Shropshire:</u> Overall National Rankings and Deciles

## **About the Indices of Deprivation**


The English Indices of Deprivation 2015 [IMD 2015] data is provided by the Department for Communities and Local Government (© Crown Copyright 2016). It provides an indication of deprivation at Lower Super Output Area [LSOA] level, a small area statistical geography.

The overall national rankings combine information from several domains which each focus on a particular type of deprivation.

For the overall national rankings, all of the 32,844 LSOAs in England have been given a ranking, with 1 being the most deprived LSOA. The LSOAs have also been divided, based on their rankings, into ten groups or Deciles with Decile 1 containing the 10% most deprived LSOAs in England.

#### Shropshire's LSOAs


Shropshire Unitary Authority has 193 LSOAs which are spread across all ten Deciles, with 47.7% of LSOAs belonging to Deciles 1 to 5. As the chart below shows, nine LSOAs fall within the 20% most deprived LSOAs in England.

# Indices of Deprivation 2015 for Lower Super Output Areas in Shropshire: Overall National Rankings and Deciles **LSOAs within the Council Areas**

Shropshire Unitary Authority can be divided into three areas (North, Central and South). Whilst each area contains a similar number of LSOAs (68 in North, 61 in Central and 64 in South) and all areas have LSOAs falling within a wide range of Deciles, the following chart highlights that the Central Area has the largest number of LSOAs in the most deprived 20% of LSOAs nationally.

## **Most Deprived LSOAs in Shropshire**

- Looking at the top ten most deprived LSOAs in Shropshire, all of the LSOAs are located within Shropshire's main towns of Shrewsbury, Ludlow, Oswestry, Market Drayton and Whitchurch.
- Five of the top ten most deprived LSOAs in Shropshire are located within the Shrewsbury area.
- Three of the highest ranking Shrewsbury LSOAs are located in the north-east of the town, in the Harlescott and Sundorne areas.
- The one LSOA in Shropshire within national Decile 1, ranked 1,779 out of 32,844 LSOAs in England, is located within Harlescott Electoral Division.
