

Small Society Lottery Declaration

Shropshire Council is required to ensure that any Society registered for the purposes of a Small Society Lottery meet the definition of a “society”. The Council also needs to understand the purposes for which a Society has been established and ensure that it is a non-commercial organisation. Section 19 of the Act defines a society as such if it is established and conducted:

- For charitable purposes, (as defined by section 2 of the Charities Act 2006)
- For the purpose of enabling participation in, or of supporting, sport, athletics or a cultural activity; or
- For any other non-commercial purpose other than that of private gain.

The Society must have been established for one of the permitted purposes, and that the proceeds of any lottery must be devoted to those purposes. Furthermore, it is not permissible to establish a society whose sole purpose is to facilitate lotteries - it must have some other purpose.
