

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SHROPSHIRE

THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL
(FOOTPATH ADDITION, PARISH OF
CONDOVER) MODIFICATION ORDER 2024

The above-named Order made on 27th June 2024 by The Shropshire Council (“the Council”) if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by **adding**: -

A footpath to be added from Point A on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 4830 0347 where it leaves the County Road between Dorrington and Condover, running in a general south easterly direction passing Sytche Cottage and Sytche Villa, then turning to follow a general southerly direction along an enclosed hedged track. It passes Sytche Farm (SJ 4849 0319) where there are several residences and then continues in a southerly direction as an unsurfaced farm track to a point where it meets the eastern section of Footpath 35 Condover (SJ 4844 0297) then continues to Point B on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 4841 0290 where it meets the western section of Footpath 35 Condover. The whole route has a width varying between 3 and 4 metres and with a total length of approximately 650 metres.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Rights of Way Manager, Shropshire Outdoor Partnerships, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND or by email to outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk not later than 8th August 2024 and you are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the Council has by notice to Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order). If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
