NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 62/63 (PART) PARISH OF WORFIELD) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024.

On 31st October 2024, The Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above named order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to **divert** the full width of FP 62 and part of FP 63 leaving the A454 at point A on the Order map at grid reference SO 7399 9391 running in a general ESE, easterly then ESE direction on a natural surface, in between plant equipment on a stoned surface to point B on the Order map at grid reference SO 7439 9395. A distance of approximately 451 metres <u>onto a line</u> leaving point B on the Order map at grid reference SO 7439 9395 running in a general northerly direction then north easterly direction on a natural surface to join the highway verge of the A454 at point C on the Order map at grid reference SO 7438 9408. A distance of approximately 146 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout its length.

Shropshire Council certify that the order becomes operative on 30th October 2024 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 31st October 2024 make an application to the High Court.
