Notice is hereby given that a Public Bridleway in the Town of Shrewsbury has been created by agreements with the landowners under Section 25, Highways Act 1980. The effect of the agreements is to create a Bridleway in the Town of Shrewsbury from SJ 4980 1399 where it meets Bridleway UN52 and Greenfields Cycleways running in a general ESE direction along a stoned track under the railway bridge and then turns to run in a general southerly direction along a tarmacked track to SJ 4982 1377 where it meets the County Road known as Marshalls Court. The width of the route varies between 2 and 4 metres throughout and the length of the route is a total distance of approximately 240 metres.
