

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND  
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 62/63 (PART) PARISH OF WORFIELD)  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024.**

The above named order made on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2024 by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A (2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert

The full width of FP 62 and part of FP 63 leaving the A454 at point A on the Order map at grid reference SO 7399 9391 running in a general ESE, easterly then ESE direction on a natural surface, in between plant equipment on a stoned surface to point B on the Order map at grid reference SO 7439 9395. A distance of approximately 451 metres **onto a line** leaving point B on the Order map at grid reference SO 7439 9395 running in a general northerly direction then north easterly direction on a natural surface to join the highway verge of the A454 at point C on the Order map at grid reference SO 7438 9408. A distance of approximately 146 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout its length.

If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
