**Shropshire Site Allocations & Management of Development Plan Examination  
Request for 'main modifications'**

In your Initial Questions you requested that the Council considers the need to make 'main modifications' if required to make the Plan sound under section 20(7C) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended). Please accept this letter as a formal notification to request modifications under section 20(7C). The Council accepts that all proposed main modifications will need to be subject to a 6 week consultation and Sustainability Appraisal if necessary at an appropriate stage in the wider examination timeframe.

Having reassessed the level and scope of each proposed minor change, the Council now considers a number of proposed changes potentially go beyond the definition of minor 'additional modifications' outlined in your recent letter, i.e. typographical errors, minor editing and factual or name changes. These are set out in the accompanying schedule (CD32), if considered necessary the Council would welcome the opportunity to consider these as 'main modifications'.
