The Plan is not sound because infrastructural deficiencies appear to be ignored whereas they ought to be a prime consideration at this stage. To do otherwise is a major dereliction of duty by the Council. In particular the Mount Farm Development will create problems to current local householders with foul water drainage and, for those in Wellfield Way, road access. Re the former the Developer, DWH Mercia, inform me that Welsh Water are carrying out a survey but will not report until after their planning application (14/01264/FUL) has been determined by the Council! I believe there may be similar problems in other areas of Whitchurch. Does the Council want a repeat of the problems in Tilstock? Re the road access, Haroldgate complies with national standards, i.e. it is 5.5 metres wide but the double curve over a short distance means that 2 HGVs cannot pass without at least one mounting the pavement. Also the gradient makes the road impassable in moderately icy conditions. The residents of the 14 houses in Wellfield Way have coped with this, I am not confident that the residents of an additional 100 houses will feel the same. Therefore the Council should be considering major road improvements or an alternative access e.g. to Chester Road. Perhaps the whole Development should be resited in that direction.
