SAMDev final plan Church Stretton

In general I support the main proposals in the *Final Plan for Church Stretton* but wish to comment on a number of issues.

- 1 **Numbers of houses**; I <u>object</u> to the proposal to build 370 houses in Church Stretton. I have still not seen any evidence in relation to local housing needs that supports the building of so many houses. This target can only be achieved by extending the bouldary of the town and damaging the AONB
- 2 **School playing field:** I <u>support</u> the use of the playing field for building houses, but only as a last resort.
- 3 **Battlefield:** The building of 50 dwellings on this site is <u>supported</u> as the site is next to the current boundary.
- 4 **Employment land/Springbank Farm:** I <u>support</u> the use of this site for offices and light industry. It will increase the traffic along Shrewsbury Road and appropriate management will be needed.
- 5 **Release of further greenfield land:** I am <u>concerned</u> about the reference to the possible need for more land on the east side of the A49 if that means developing the land at New House Farm. I strongly object to the spread of housing on this area as it would do irreparable damage to this attractive hillside which sits in the AONB.
