As an introduction Sue told us about her journey with Social Care and her involvement with The Making It Real Board, as well as some of the history of The Making It Real Board.

At the moment The Board is doing Co production at the operational or strategic levels, but we should also be making sure Co production is happening at the individual level where peoples' support plans are being worked out.

Currently there is no forum for people to come to talk about their concerns about their support plan.

Sue feels we have drifted from The Making It Real Framework. It's all documented.

A long and open discussion was had on this. Many of the Experts agreed with Sue but stated that they enjoyed the Co production that they had been doing and would like to continue that as well.

Laura asked what the group wanted to be involved with Co Production or to be more involved with individuals' issues. The council will support whatever the group decides.

Action Plan – A group to be formed to discuss what the focus of the board should be.

Other questions to be answered: -

- 1. Can Coproduction and Making IT Real Coexist or do they need to be separate?
- 2. Should we bring back Advisory groups back, all be it with a different name and maybe a slightly different structure?
- 3. Should the Board have more Social Workers?
- 4. What about Armchair Panels, how would they work?

Publicising Making IT Real

Feedback Mechanism

We have a feedback form on the website hard copies were put out as well. It's been there for 12 months. There have been 6 responses.

Complaints need to go through the complaints process. The need to listen to partner organisations too. We need to think about how to promote it. People need to feel really listened to. If workers don't respond then it needs to escalate through the hierarchy – senior managers, assistant directors and so on. There has to be a valid reason why people don't respond. Sophie Raising Awareness Of Making It Real We've been allocated a slot on Social Work Week – 22.3.24 11- 12 to talk about Making It Real and Co Production. Workshop at The Adult Social Care Conference at the Shropshire Council Developing a Comms plan to raise awareness of Making It Real, including regular contributions into the Three-minute brief, putting information about Making It Real and Co Production onto the Lock screen of Council employees' computers. Sophie and **Updates On Policies, Guidance and Frameworks** Rachel The documents need to be all age, so they can be adopted right across the people's directorate. This shouldn't slow them down. **Payment Schedule** Laura to look at Payment schedule to add the relevant bits for children and young people. We need to get it done. **Engagement Policy** We need an Expert's Engagement Policy not just a handbook. It will be easier to call it Guidance instead of a policy as far as governance, oversight and signing it off but it will be the same, in all but name as a policy. We need to know what happens if things need to be escalated. Needs to be Co-Produced. A meeting to be arranged. Co production framework Ready to go. Just needs a few changes to make it all age.

Policies will be adopted by all boards.

Rationalisation of the boards
