

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 15E PARISH OF PREES)
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2024**

The above named order made on 25th July 2024, by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will **extinguish**;

The full width of Footpath 15E from Point A on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 5672 3498 running across horse paddocks, an arable field and livestock pens in a south easterly direction where it continues into the curtilage of the property called Gerayne and directly through the house where it then meets the County Road at point B at grid reference: SJ 5710 3485. A total distance of approximately 405 metres.

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
