

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND  
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 36 (PART), PARISH OF  
MINSTERLEY) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2025**

On 24<sup>th</sup> April 2025, The Shropshire Council (the “Council”) confirmed the above-named order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the order as confirmed is to **extinguish**; the whole width of footpath 36 (part) from SJ 3578 0510 running in a general east, then ESE, then SE direction to SJ 3616 0490. Approximate distance: 440 metres. The order comes into force on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2025; but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 24<sup>th</sup> April 2025 make an application to the High Court.
