When I get to the library I will see a desk.



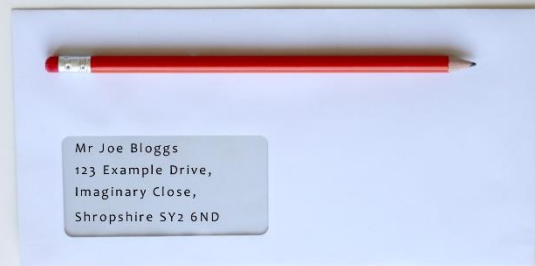
I will talk to someone who works there to become a member of the library.

When I visit the library

I can sit in a chair to read a book.



I can borrow a book and take it home with me.



If I want to borrow a book I will talk to a member of the library staff.



The staff will show me how to borrow the book and tell me when I need to bring it back to the library.



The library will also have some computers.



The computers are free to use.



To use the computers, I will need to talk to a member of staff who will find me an available computer or reserve one for me for a later time.



When I have finished, I will leave the library.
