## What is a special educational need?

A child or young person has a special educational need (SEN) if they have a learning difficulty or disability that requires special educational provision.

A **diagnosis is not always needed** to have SEN.

Your child may have SEN if they:

- Have significantly greater difficulty learning than most others their age.
- Have a disability that prevents them from accessing mainstream school facilities.
