Bridleway UN5 CHURCH STRETTON
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14
Temporary Prohibition of Use of Bridleway UN5, Church Stretton

Shropshire Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the highway authority for the length of bridleway specified in the Schedule to this Order, is satisfied that traffic in the said length of bridleway should be regulated by reason of works to be executed on or near the said length of bridleway.

The Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

1. The use of the bridleway described in the Schedule to this order is hereby prohibited.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from proceeding in the length of bridleway specified in that Article if that person is carrying out work in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that said length of bridleway.
3. This Order shall come into operation on 2nd January 2025 until 2nd July 2025 (in the first instance) and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Temporary Prohibition of Use of Bridleway UN5, Church Stretton) Order 2025.

BWUN5 Church Stretton which runs from the B5477 Ludlow Road at grid reference SO 4456 9295, running in a general northerly, then north-east direction through Hopes Wood to grid reference SO 4481 9354.
