#### DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SHROPSHIRE

#### THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (BRIDLEWAY ADDITION, PARISH OF STOKE-ON-TERN AND PARISH OF HODNET) MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

This Order is made by The Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Council that the Shropshire Definitive Map and Statement require modification because in accordance with the provisions of Section 53(3)(c)(i) the Council has discovered evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows -

- (i) that a right of way which is not shown on the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic

The Council hereby order that:

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 2nd August 2022.
2. The Shropshire Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the maps attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Bridleway Addition, Parish of Stoke-on-Tern and Parish of Hodnet) Modification Order 2022.

## **SCHEDULE**

### **PART I**

#### **Modification of Definitive Map**

##### **Description of path or way to be added**

A bridleway to be added from the County Road, adjacent to the property Ollerton Lodge, at point A on the Order Map (SJ 6470 2535) running in a general south-westerly direction along a metalled track, then passing through a double field gate and continuing in the same direction along the track and through a field gate, then continuing along the track in the same general south-westerly direction to another field gate. From there it continues on the track over a bridge across a watercourse and across a second bridge over the River Tern, then rising up an incline before turning to run in a general north-westerly, then south-westerly direction to terminate on the County Road, adjacent to Peplow Chapel, at point B on the Order Map (SJ 6363 2475). A total distance of approximately 1281m in length and a width varying between 3m and 5m.

### **PART II**

#### **Modification of Definitive Statement**

A bridleway to be added from the County Road, adjacent to the property Ollerton Lodge, at point A on the Order Map (SJ 6470 2535) running in a general south-westerly direction along a metalled track, then passing through a double field gate and continuing in the same direction along the track and through a field gate, then continuing along the track in the same general south-westerly direction to another field gate. From there it continues
