The above order was made on 21st May 2026. The effect of the order will be to stop up

The full width of that part of 74 leaving point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 4959 1009 running in a southerly direction to point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 4959 1008 A distance of approximately 5 metres.

If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
