Dear Occupant

As you are aware works are ongoing on Station Quarter gyratory system consisting of public realm pavement works, cycle lanes and traffic signal modifications to assist movement of traffic and pedestrians through this location.

The works to bring the cycleway along Castle Foregate and into New Park Road will commence on 12th May 2025.

This work will mainly consist of new kerb lines along East footway, widening of the footway and new surfacing to footway and carriageway which will allow a shared footway / cycleway and run from Howard Street, turn up New Park Road and then along the old canal. A new pedestrian crossing will be installed on New Park Road.

Once the footway works are completed the existing carriageway will be planned off and new tarmac surfacing laid which will tie in with the new surfacing to be laid around the Station gyratory.

In order for the works to be completed safely and allow vehicular and pedestrian passage through the works the "On Street" parking will be suspended from 19th May for approx. 9 weeks.

If safe to do so as work progresses parking bays will be re-opened where possible. The "On Street" parking will be retained as part of the completed scheme.

The final carriageway surfacing will be carried out in early July at night.

Works will commence from Howard Street and work towards New Park Road.

With on street parking suspended we will maintain 2-way traffic at all times [except for carriageway surfacing]. Temporary traffic lights will be in place when work reaches New Park Road junction to allow traffic to be controlled.

Pedestrian or vehicular access which cross the footway will be maintained at all times where physically possible.

Whilst we understand there will be some inconvenience with this work, we aim to complete this section of work as quickly and safely as physically possible.
