

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND  
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER  
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53(A)(2)**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 38, FOOTPATH 39 & FOOTPATH 40  
(PART) TOWN OF WHITCHURCH) PUBLIC PATH STOPPING UP ORDER 2018.**

On 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025, the Shropshire Council ('the Council') confirmed the above order. The effect of the order as confirmed is to **stop up**

The full width of that part of Footpath 38 Whitchurch from point A on the Order Map at Alport Road, between properties Sheldon Oak and Withinlee (SJ 5451 4208) running in a general ESE direction then ENE direction on a natural surface to point B on the Order Map (SJ 5474 4208); a total length of approximately 254 metres.

The full width of Footpath 39 leaving a garden boundary at point D on the Order Map (SJ 5466 4199) running in a general north easterly direction on a natural surface to join with FP 38 and FP 40 at point B on the Order Map (SJ 5474 4208) ; a total length of approximately 116 metres

The full width of that part of Footpath 40 from a gate at point B on the Order Map (SJ 5451 4208) running in a general NNE direction on a grass surface to point C on the Order Map (SJ 5481 4219); a total length of approximately 141 metres.

Shropshire Council certify that the Order becomes operative on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025 but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 and 8 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
