

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION
OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (BRIDLEWAY CREATION) PARISH OF
MELVERLEY) PUBLIC PATH CREATION ORDER 2025**

On 28th November 2025, The Shropshire Council (the “Council”) confirmed the above-named Order made under section 26 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to

Create a bridleway leaving a gate at point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 3339 1754 running in a general south-south-westerly direction along a natural surface to meet Restricted Byway 22 and Footpath 22 at Point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 3336 1753. A total distance of approximately 109 metres and a width of 3 metres throughout.

Shropshire Council certify that the Order became operative on 14th July 2025 but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 28th November 2025 make an application to the High Court.
