What is the Plan-Making Timetable

Consistent with The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2026, Part 2, Regulation 4, Shropshire Council is required to publish a Plan-Making Timetable.

This Plan-Making Timetable is the 'project plan' identifying the planning policy documents Shropshire Council is intending to prepare over the next 3-year period.

Approval of Shropshire Council's Plan-Making Timetable

On the 6 May 2026 Cabinet endorsed and approved for publication the: **Shropshire Plan-Making Timetable – V1 (May 2026)**.

Enactment of Shropshire Council's Plan-Making Timetable

The Shropshire Plan-Making Timetable – V1 (May 2026) is to have effect from: **7 May 2026**.

Ensuring the Plan-Making Timetable Remains Up-To-Date

Consistent with The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2026, Part 2, Regulation 6, Shropshire Council is required to keep its Plan-Making Timetable up-to-date.

On the 6 May 2026 Cabinet delegated responsibility for subsequent reviews and undertaking necessary amendments to ensure it remains up-to-date to the Plan-Making Timetable to the Service Director for Place Shaping in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Planning.
