**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 5 (PART) & FOOTPATH 6 (PART),  
PARISH OF CHIRBURY WITH BROMPTON)  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

This Order is made by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Council that in the interests of the landowners of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the lines of these ways should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A (2) of the Wildlife Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Shropshire definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Lowfield in the Parish of Chirbury with Brompton and shown by the bold continuous lines on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this order and thereupon the Shropshire definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it these public rights of way.

2. Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this Order statutory undertakers shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 above, namely: Where immediately before the date on which these footpaths are diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same right in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

3. There shall on the date of confirmation of this Order be two public footpaths over the land situated at Lowfield in the Parish of Chirbury with Brompton as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the map contained in this Order and thereupon the Shropshire definitive map shall be modified by adding these paths to it.

3A. The Shropshire definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this order.

4. The diversion of the footpaths shall only have effect on the date on which Shropshire Council certifies that any works required to bring the footpaths into a fit condition have been carried out.

5. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

## **SCHEDULE**

### **PART I**

#### **Description of site of existing path or way**

##### **Footpath 5 (part)**

The full width of Chirbury with Brompton Footpath 5 (part) commencing from the County Road at grid reference SJ 2909 0313, Point A on the Order Map, running in a general west-northwest direction to grid reference SJ 2888 0321, Point B on the Order Map. A total distance of approximately 230 metres.

##### **Footpath 6 (part)**

The full width of Chirbury with Brompton Footpath 6 (part) commencing from grid reference SJ 2874 0301, Point D on the Order Map, running in a general north-northeast direction, across a brook with no crossing point, to grid reference SJ 2891 0332, Point E on the Order Map. A total distance of approximately 360 metres.

### **PART 2**

#### **Description of site of new path or way**

A footpath will be created commencing from the County Road at grid reference SJ 2909 0313, Point A on the Order Map, and then running in a general south-southwest then south-west direction, on the west of a roadside fence line to grid reference SJ 2901 0302, continuing in a general west-northwest direction along a field edge to where it meets Footpath 6 at grid reference SJ 2883 0310, Point C on the Order Map. A total distance of approximately 340 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

**AND**

A footpath will be created from grid reference SJ 2874 0301, Point D on the Order Map, and then running along an unsealed track in a general north-east direction to grid reference SJ 2888 0318, continuing in a general northerly, then north-northeast direction, across a culvert at grid reference SJ 2889 0326, to meet the continuation of Footpath 6 at grid reference SJ 2891 0332, Point E on the Order Map. A total distance of approximately 370 metres, with a width of 2 metres throughout.

### **PART 3**

#### **Limitations and conditions**

Gates to BS 5709 located at grid references: SJ 2901 0302 and SJ 2883 0310

### **PART 4**

#### **Modification of Definitive Statement**

A footpath will be created commencing from the County Road at grid reference SJ 2909 0313, Point A on the Order Map, and then running in a general south-southwest then south-west direction, on the west of a roadside fence line to grid reference SJ 2901 0302, continuing in a general west-northwest direction along a field edge to where it meets Footpath 6 at grid reference SJ 2883 0310, Point C on the Order Map. A total distance of approximately 340 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

#### **AND**

A footpath will be created from grid reference SJ 2874 0301, Point D on the Order Map, and then running along an unsealed track in a general north-east direction to grid reference SJ 2888 0318, continuing in a general northerly, then north-northeast direction, across a culvert at grid reference SJ 2889 0326, to meet the continuation

of Footpath 6 at grid reference SJ 2891 0332, Point E on the Order Map. A total distance of approximately 370 metres, with a width of 2 metres throughout.

There is no Shropshire definitive statement for the remainder of either of these Rights of Way.
