## THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL BRIDLEWAY 7B (PART) PARISH OF CAYNHAM PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025

The above named order made on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2025 by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will **divert** 

The full width of that part of BW 7B leaving BW 9 at point A on the Order map at grid reference SO 5872 7588 running in a general westerly direction on a natural surface, alongside Percys Cottage to point B on the Order map at grid reference SO 5885 7585. A total distance of approximately 138 metres **onto a line** leaving BW 9/BW 5 at point C on the Order map at grid reference SO 5877 7594 running in a general south easterly direction to a gate then continuing in an ESE direction to rejoin the Definitive line of BW 9 at point B on the Order map at grid reference SO 5885 7585. A distance of approximately 180 metres, on a natural surface with a width of 3 metres throughout its length.
