

## NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

### WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SHROPSHIRE

#### THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH ADDITION, PARISH OF ADDERLEY) MODIFICATION ORDER 2018

The above named Order made on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2018, by The Shropshire Council (“the Council”) if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

adding a Footpath from the County boundary at point A on the Order Map (SJ 6629 4025) at a junction with the County Road and Bridleway 10 Adderley, running in a general north-north-easterly then east-north-easterly direction following a driveway to Pool House where it crosses the yard and runs between buildings passing through a gate (SJ 6648 4042) then continues across a pasture field to Adderley Pool Bridge over the Shropshire Union Canal where there is access to the canal towpath. The path then passes through a gate (SJ 6656 4052) where it turns to run in a general northerly direction across an arable field to point B on the order Map (SJ 6655 4075), a distance of approximately 645 metres. From here the route splits and a western arm of the path continues in a general northerly direction through a field boundary via a gate (SJ 6655 4099) to become a field edge path running to point C on the Order Map (SJ 6647 4122) at the County boundary and a junction with Footpath 6 in the Parish of Audlem, Cheshire, a distance of approximately 490 metres. From point B an eastern arm of the path runs in general north-north-easterly direction through a field boundary via a gate (SJ 6661 4099) and runs to point D on the Order Map (SJ 6678 4134) at the County boundary and a junction with Footpath 10 in the Parish of Audlem, Cheshire, a distance of approximately 655 metres. The path is a total distance of approximately 1790 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at the Council offices at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours. Copies of the Order and map may also be bought from the Shropshire Council at the above address at a cost of £6.50. Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Shropshire Outdoor Partnerships, Rights of Way Mapping and Enforcement Manager, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND, or by email to [outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk](mailto:outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk). not later than 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2018 and you are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the Council has by notice to Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order). If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
