

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53(A)(2)**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH UN21 (PART)
TOWN OF BROSELEY) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024.**

On 28th November 2024, the Shropshire Council ('the Council') confirmed the above order. The effect of the order as confirmed is to

Divert The full width of that part of FP UN21 leaving point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 6706 0166 running in a general WSW then westerly direction to point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 6723 0164. A distance of approximately 62 metres **onto a line** leaving Park View at the stile at point C on the Order map at grid reference SJ 6729 0164 with a width of 1 metre then opening out to 2 metres, running in a general WSW then north westerly direction on a stoned surface to re-join the definitive line of FP UN21 at point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 6723 0164. A distance of approximately 80 metres.

This order comes into force on the date on which Shropshire Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 and 8 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
