

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SHROPSHIRE

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH ADDITIONS, PARISH OF
WESTON-UNDER-REDCASTLE) MODIFICATION ORDER 2019**

The above named Order made on 26th September 2019 by The Shropshire Council ("the Council") if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

adding a footpath from point A on Order Map 1 (SJ 5668 2769) where it leaves Restricted Byway 4, running in a general south westerly direction for a few metres to a gap alongside a field gate, then turning to follow a general westerly direction along an enclosed track, with a width varying between 3 and 7.5 metres, continuing to run adjacent to the northern boundary of Weston Heath Coppice and continuing to enter the woodland at SJ 5609 2772 from where the route becomes a woodland path with a width varying between 2 and 6.5 metres, running in a general westerly direction for a short distance then turning to run in a general north westerly direction before curving round to run down a steep incline in a general south westerly direction, then continuing in a general south-south-westerly direction to its junction with Restricted Byway 4 at point B on Order Map 1 (SJ 5569 2778); a total distance of approximately 1163 metres.

and

adding a footpath from point A on Order Map 2 (SJ 5623 2771), running in a general southerly followed by south westerly direction descending through Weston Heath Coppice, with a width of 2 metres, to its junction with Restricted Byway 4 at point B on Order Map 2 (SJ5597 2736); a total distance of approximately 483 metres.

A copy of the Order and the Order maps may be seen free of charge at the Council offices at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours. Copies of the Order and maps may also be bought from the Shropshire Council at the above address at a price of £6.50.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Mapping and Enforcement Manager, Outdoor Partnerships, Infrastructure and Communities, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND or by email to outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk, not later than 8th November 2019 and you are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the Council has by notice to Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order). If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
