

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION  
OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP  
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

BRIDLEWAY 7B (PART) PARISH OF CAYNHAM  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

On 25<sup>th</sup> September 2025, The Shropshire Council (the “Council”) confirmed the above-named Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert

The full width of that part of BW 7B leaving BW 9 at point A on the Order map at grid reference SO 5872 7588 running in a general westerly direction on a natural surface, alongside Percys Cottage to point B on the Order map at grid reference SO 5885 7585. A total distance of approximately 138 metres onto a line leaving BW 9/BW 5 at point C on the Order map at grid reference SO 5877 7594 running in a general south easterly direction to a gate then continuing in an ESE direction to rejoin the Definitive line of BW 9 at point B on the Order map at grid reference SO 5885 7585. A distance of approximately 180 metres, on a natural surface with a width of 3 metres throughout its length.

Shropshire Council certify that the Order became operative on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2025 but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 25<sup>th</sup> September 2025 make an application to the High Court.
