THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (FARLEY ROAD, MUCH WENLOCK) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2025

On 16 September 2025 Shropshire Council made an order to introduce the following parking restrictions around the William Brookes School in Much Wenlock:

Prohibition of stopping on School Keep Clear entrance markings

No Waiting or Loading At Any Time

A4169 Farley Road	Eastern side of the carriageway	Commencing from a point 153.2m north of the northern boundary of No.16 The Crescent for a distance of 3.2m in a northerly direction.
A4169 Farley Road	Eastern side of the carriageway	Commencing from a point 188.0m north of the

northern boundary of No.16 The Crescent for a distance of 3.7m in a northerly direction.

No Waiting Monday to Saturday 8am-6pm

Western side of the A4169 Farley Commencing from a point 12m north of its junction Road carriageway with Foresters Gardens for a distance of 106m in a northerly direction. Eastern side of the A4169 Farley Commencing from its Road junction with Foresters carriageway Gardens (centre of road) for a distance of 102m in a northerly direction.

These changes will come into effect on 22 September 2025.

A copy of the order may be examined during normal office hours (8:45am-5:00pm Monday to Thursday, and 8:45am-4:00pm on Fridays) at Shropshire Council, The Guildhall, Frankwell, Shrewsbury.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provisions in it, on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 16 September 2025, apply for that purpose to the High Court.
