## NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

## THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 177 (PART) PARISH OF BARROW) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025.

The above named order made on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2025 by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert

The full width of that part of Footpath 177 leaving the County Road at point A on the Order map at grid reference SO 6511 9858 running in a general WSW direction along the access track to a kissing gate, then in a general SSE then WSW direction through a kissing gate, passing close to the wood yard buildings into the adjoining field through a kissing gate. From here the footpath runs in a general south westerly direction to a kissing gate at point B on the Order map at grid reference SO 6469 982. The total length of the route to be extinguished measures approximately 592 metres and is subject to four gates **onto a line** leaving the County Road at a gate at Point A on the Order Map at grid reference SO 65119858 running in a general SSW direction to a gap between trees in the field boundary, it then turns in a general WSW direction to an existing kissing gate at point B on the Order Map at grid reference SO 64699824. The footpath to be created passes over natural surface throughout. The total length of the route to be created is approximately 630 metres, with a minimum width of 2 metres throughout.
