Benefits of registration – vision impaired

Below is a summary of the main benefits of registration for Severely Sight Impaired (SSI – Blind) and Sight Impaired (SI – Partially Sighted).

- 1. Free NHS Sight Test if you are registered SSI or SI. To find out more visit https://www.nhs.uk/nhs-eye-tests-and-optical-vouchers/
- 2. Blue Badge Scheme Blue Badges allow parking concessions and are available automatically to people registered SSI. People registered SI with additional disabilities may also qualify. - 3. Travel Concessions you may be entitled if you are registered SSI or SI. To find out more, contact 0345 6789 088 or visit http://shropshire.gov.uk/concessionary-travel-scheme/
- 4. Disabled Person's Rail Card entitles you to 1/3 off most rail fares throughout the UK. If you are travelling with an adult companion, they are also eligible for the same discount. - 5. Welfare Benefits If you are registered SSI or SI, you may be entitled to certain financial benefits. To find out more, contact 0345 6789 002 or visit https://shropshire.gov.uk/benefits/
- 6. Blind Person's Allowance an extra amount of tax-free allowance for people registered SSI. To find out more visit https://www.gov.uk/blind-persons-allowance

7. VAT Exemption – If you are registered SSI or SI, you may be eligible to purchase products and services without paying VAT on them, if they are related to your sight loss. 8. Free postage on items marked 'Articles for the Blind' – a scheme for Royal Mail customers who are registered SSI. To find out more visit
