THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF BRIDGNORTH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2007 (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER 2024

On 22 August 2024 Shropshire Council made an order to make the following changes to the speed limit on the A458 around Much Wenlock:

30mph speed limit

A458 Shrewsbury Road, Much Wenlock.

From a point 40 metres north-west of its junction with the B4371 Stretton Road to a point 214 metres northwest of that junction (a distance of 174 metres).

40mph speed limit

A458 Much Wenlock to Beggarhill Crossroads.

From a point 42 metres south-east of its junction with Oakfield Park to a point 432 metres south-east of that junction.

Any existing speed limits at these locations will be revoked.

These changes will come into effect on 30 August 2024.

A copy of the order may be examined during normal office hours (8:45am-5:00pm Monday to Thursday, and 8:45am-4:00pm on Fridays) at Shropshire Council, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury SY2 6ND.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provisions in it, on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 22 August 2024, apply for that purpose to the High Court.
