Capital Infrastructure works	<p>Joe Bubb provided an update with regard to the activities planned and proposed at Mile End which forms part of the Council's long-term ambitions for the Oswestry Growth Corridor integrated with the development of the town centre.</p> <p>The capital infrastructure proposals at Mile End incorporates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mile End Road Improvements • Proposed Footbridge across the A5 • Enabling works for the Oswestry Innovation Park <p>The Planning Application for the road improvements at Mile End was approved by Shropshire Council in June 2020. The works currently being undertaken onsite are limited to ecological mitigation, alongside archaeological investigation, which are related to the planned road improvements. The main road works are due to commence in the New Year following site establishment from early December.</p> <p>The bid to the Marches LEP for Growth Deal 3 monies was successful aimed to support the improvements to the strategic road network and to support the development of allocated employment land at the Oswestry Innovation Park site. The LEP funding has supported the preparation of an addendum to the approved planning application for the road improvements to include the proposed footbridge.</p> <p>OTC noted formal responses on planning portal – a response will be provided.</p> <p>The LEP funding has also supported design fees for the development of the Oswestry Innovation Park. A planning application is currently in preparation for the proposed Oswestry Innovation Park</p> <p>Public consultation due to begin for 6 weeks. BID to promote and suggest promotion via Oswestry Life.</p> <p>The work on the business park to undertake infrastructure work is dependent on the road improvements and can start in earnest once the road improvements are completed, which are scheduled for completion by summer 2022.</p>	<p>JB/SarahJ</p> <p>Andy Morris</p>
