

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257 & 261**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 14/16 PARISH OF BUILDWAS)
TEMPORARY PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025.**

On 6th March 2025, the Shropshire Council ('the Council') confirmed the above order.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to

temporarily divert (until 9th January 2031) the full width of FP 14/16 leaving point A on the Order map on the A4169 Much Wenlock Road at grid reference SJ 6431 0400 running in a general south easterly then easterly direction to join with BW 16 at point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 6490 0393. A distance of approximately 649 metres.

A temporary alternative length of Footpath 14/16, with a width of 2 metres will be provided (until 9th January 2031) leaving point C on the Order map on the A4169 Much Wenlock Road at grid reference SJ 6418 0391 following the field boundary in a general WSW, south easterly then ENE direction then across field in a general ESE then SSE direction. The footpath then continues in a general easterly then northerly direction, following the field boundary on its southern side to rejoin with BW 16 at point D on the Order map at grid reference SJ 6498 0373. A distance of approximately 764 metres.

This order comes into force on the date on which Shropshire Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 and 8 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
