

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND  
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 64, PARISH OF WORTHEN WITH SHELVE)  
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2019**

The above named order made on 14<sup>th</sup> February 2019 by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980, will **extinguish**

the full width of Footpath 64 Worthen with Shelve to be extinguished from point A on the Order Map (SJ 3008 0434), running in a general north easterly direction crossing Weston Brook and then following a woodland and scrub field margin of a pasture field. It continues as a field edge path to join Footpath 65 at point B on the Order Map (SJ 3046 0460); a total distance of approximately 490 metres.

A copy of the order and the order map and an explanatory statement have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Council offices at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours or via the Council’s website at

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
