



**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 10Y (PART) PARISH OF
PONTESBURY) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

This Order is made by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Council that in the interests of the landowner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the way should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A (2) of the Wildlife Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Shropshire definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Pontesbury Sewage Works and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this Order and thereupon the Shropshire definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.

2. Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this Order statutory undertakers shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 above, namely:

Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is

apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same right in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

3. There shall on the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated at Pontesbury Sewage Works described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order and thereupon the Shropshire definitive map shall be modified by adding that path to it.

3A. The Shropshire definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this order.

4. The diversion of the footpath shall only have effect on the date on which Shropshire Council certifies that any works required to bring the footpath into a fit condition have been carried out.

5. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART I

Description of site of existing path or way

The full width of that part of Footpath 10Y from Point **A** on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 3987 0638 where it leaves the footbridge across the brook and passes in a north easterly direction through a pasture field before veering north westerly to meet the route of Footpath 10Y at Point **B** on the Order Map at grid reference: SJ 3993 0652 . A total distance of approximately 175 metres.

PART 2

Description of site of new path or way

From point **A** on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 3987 0638 heading in a westerly and then north westerly direction to follow the field edge. It will then run alongside an existing stoned access track in a north easterly direction, before crossing the track to continue in a further north easterly direction to meet the current route of Footpath 10Y at Point **B** on the Order map at grid reference: SJ 3993 0652. A total distance of approximately 320 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout its length.

Modification of Definitive Statement

From point **A** on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 3987 0638 heading in a westerly and then north westerly direction to follow the field edge. It will then run alongside an

A total distance of approximately 320 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout its length.

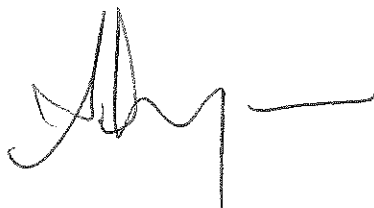

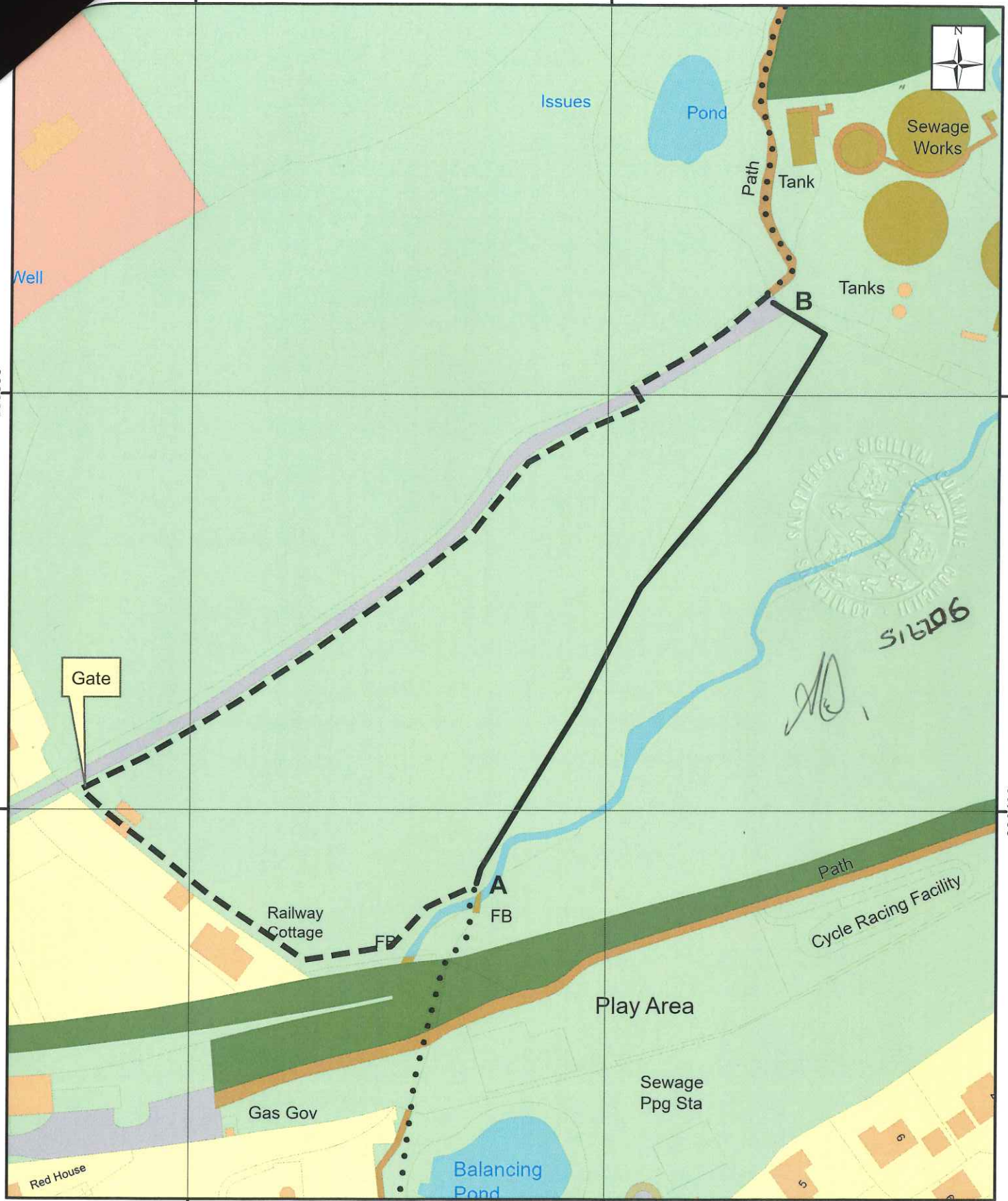
