Theatre Severn

Theatre Severn, Frankwell Quay, Shrewsbury SY3 8FT

Set on the banks of the river, Theatre Severn is one of the county's most popular cultural venues. It hosts approximately 600 different shows per year across a 650-seat main auditorium and the 250-seat Walker Theatre. Productions include drama, ballet, opera, stand-up comedy, contemporary and classical music concerts, and family friendly productions, with the biggest show of the year being the pantomime. The theatre has a popular bar, restaurant, dance studio and gallery.

This high footfall venue welcomes over 200,000 visitors per year, the majority are from Shropshire.

Shows hosted at Theatre Severn vary so there is no single 'typical theatre goer' profile. Each show attracts a different audience reflecting the nature of the show. The pantomime that runs throughout December is the biggest show of the year and welcomes a mainly local family audience. Other shows will attract people of different ages, genders and life stages.



Old Market Hall, The Square Shrewsbury SY1 1LH

Dominating The Square in Shrewsbury town centre the magnificent medieval Old Market Hall is now an independent cinema screening a combination of box office favourites, independent films and arts performance screenings. The venue offers a high-quality cinema in an 80 seater auditorium with a Café Bar that is open to all.

With up to three screenings a day plus a busy trade in the café bar, the Old Market Hall welcomes over 100,000 visitors per year. Severn Valley Country Park


With the River Severn cutting through the centre of this former industrial site, the Severn Valley Country Park now offers a refuge for people and wildlife. Hundreds of acres of former industrial landscape have been given back to nature and now feature a variety of walks and trails surrounded by rich biodiversity.

The park features accessible paths and trails, a visitor centre, play areas and canoe launches. It welcomes over 100,000 visitors per year from Shropshire and the West Midlands. Popular with schools, families, dog walkers, runners, naturalists and those who just want to enjoy a bit of fresh air, the park is a rural retreat for all.

Each library has its own unique user base, mainly reflecting the local community. Across the network we welcome 644400 visitors a year.








Shropshire Archives

Shropshire Archives holds over 6 miles of documents relating to the history of the historic county. This includes charters and deeds, beautiful maps and plans as well as minutes, letters, diaries, photographs, drawings and watercolours. The building also houses a fantastic local history reference library. This wealth of information helps tell the stories of Shropshire. The Archives is free to use and is open to everyone. People visit the archives for many reasons – to research their community or locality, for house history, academic research, legal investigations or family history. The Archives supports school visits and runs a varied programme of events and talks.

Shropshire Archives is supported by an active Friends group who help purchase equipment, conservation materials and books.
