

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SHROPSHIRE
THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL
(FOOTPATH ADDITION, PARISH OF
WORTHEN WITH SHELVE) MODIFICATION ORDER 2023

The above named Order made on 16th February 2023 by The Shropshire Council (“the Council”) if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

adding the claimed route commencing at Point A on the Order Map, grid reference SJ 3744 0221 and running in a south westerly direction along the full width of the bed of a disused industrial light railway. It is crossed by Footpath 92Z and continues in a south westerly direction with the path narrowing to 2 metres. The path follows a terrace along which the railway used to run, it then leaves the old railway and continues as a narrow hillside path with a width of 0.5 metres to a gate at Point B grid reference SJ 3701 0152, then turns to run in a south easterly direction to join Footpath 91 at Crowsnest Dingle Point C, grid reference SJ 3707 0146. The width varies between 0.5 metres and 5 metres. A total distance of approximately 950 metres.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Rights of Way Mapping and Enforcement Manager, Shropshire Outdoor Partnerships, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND or by email to outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk not later than 30th March 2023 and you are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the Council has by notice to Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order). If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
