

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION
OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 21 (PART) PARISH OF EATON-
UNDER-HEYWOOD)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

On 15th May 2025, The Shropshire Council (the “Council”) confirmed the above-named Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to; **divert** the full width of Eaton-under-Heywood footpath 21 (part) commencing from SO 50062 90949, Point A on the Order Map, and then running in a general west direction to SO 4998 9094, continuing in a general west-southwest direction to meet the continuation of footpath 21 at SO 4981 9087, Point B on the Order Map, approximately 270 metres **onto a line** commencing from the County Road at SO 50057 90944, Point C on the Order Map, and then running in a general west direction on the north side of a field boundary to SO 4993 9095, continuing in a general south-west direction to where it meets the continuation of footpath 21 at SO 4981 9087, Point B on the Order Map, approximately 280 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

Shropshire Council certify that the Order became operative on 25th April 2025; but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 15th May 2025 make an application to the High Court.
