

## 20th May 2024 World Bee Day



#### 4 Ways to Help Bees Thrive

Here are a few ways to help bees thrive:

- 1. Add native plants to your garden. Native plants provide pollen and nectar to bees, which they need to feed themselves and their larvae (babies), and also provide a place to nest.
- 2. Avoid using pesticides—these chemicals harm bees.
- 3. Build a shallow garden bath with pebbles for our bee friends to catch a break and take a sip or two after foraging and collecting nectar.
- 4. Maintain bee habitats. Around 30 percent of bees live in holes inside trees, logs, or hollow plant stems.









Bees pollinate our wild trees and wild flowers, which then support other insects, which then support birds, bats, mammals and everything up the food chain with food and shelter.










Zumba is a fitness activity that involves Latin-inspired dance.
