

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND  
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 64, PARISH OF  
WORTHEN WITH SHELVE) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2019**

On 7<sup>th</sup> March 2024, The Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above-named order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53 A (2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to **extinguish**;

the full width of Footpath 64 Worthen with Shelve to be extinguished from point A on the Order Map (SJ 3008 0434), running in a general north easterly direction crossing Weston Brook and then following a woodland and scrub field margin of a pasture field. It continues as a field edge path to join Footpath 65 at point B on the Order Map (SJ 3046 0460); a total distance of approximately 490 metres.

The order comes into force on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2024; but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 7<sup>th</sup> March 2024 make an application to the High Court.
