

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION
OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 30 PARISH OF WESTBURY) PUBLIC PATH
DIVERSION ORDER 2025.**

On 6th November 2025, The Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above-named Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to

The full width of Footpath 30 from Point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 3810 0895 running in a general north easterly direction through an orchard then turning to run in a general south easterly direction, then north easterly direction through a second orchard, to join with Footpath 31 at Point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 3849 0913. A distance of approximately 455m onto a line leaving Point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 3810 0895 running in a general SSE then ENE direction, before curling in a general south easterly, ESE, easterly then south easterly direction. The footpath will then run in a north easterly, NNW then northerly direction, to join Footpath 31 at Point C on the Order map at grid reference SJ 3856 0900. A total distance of approximately 735m, on a grass surface with a width of 2 metres throughout its length.

Shropshire Council certify that the Order became operative on 10th September 2025 but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 6th November 2025 make an application to the High Court.
