

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SHROPSHIRE

THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (BRIDLEWAY ADDITION, PARISH OF STOKE-ON-TERN AND PARISH OF HODNET) MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

The above named Order made on 18th August 2022 by The Shropshire Council (“the Council”) if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:

adding a bridleway from the County Road, adjacent to the property Ollerton Lodge, at point A on the Order Map (SJ 6470 2535) running in a general south-westerly direction along a metalled track, then passing through a double field gate and continuing in the same direction along the track and through a field gate, then continuing along the track in the same general south-westerly direction to another field gate. From there it continues on the track over a bridge across a watercourse and across a second bridge over the River Tern, then rising up an incline before turning to run in a general north-westerly, then south-westerly direction to terminate on the County Road, adjacent to Peplow Chapel, at point B on the Order Map (SJ 6363 2475). A total distance of approximately 1281m in length and a width varying between 3m and 5m.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the Mapping and Enforcement Manager, Shropshire Outdoor Partnerships, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND or by email to outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk, not later than 30th September 2022 and you are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the Council has by notice to Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order). If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
