

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION  
OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP  
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 5 (PART) & FOOTPATH 6 (PART))  
PARISH OF CHIRBURY WITH BROMPTON)  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

On 2nd April 2026, The Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above-named Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to;

**divert** the full width of Chirbury with Brompton FP5 (part) commencing from the County Road at SJ 2909 0313, Point A on the Order Map, running in a general WNW direction to SJ 2888 0321, Point B on the Order Map, approximately 230m  
**AND** the full width of Chirbury with Brompton FP6 (part) commencing from SJ 2874 0301, Point D on the Order Map, running in a general NNE direction, across a brook with no crossing point to SJ 2891 0332, Point E on the Order Map, approximately 360m **onto a line** commencing from the County Road at SJ 2909 0313, Point A on the Order Map, and then running in a general SSW then SW direction, on the west of a roadside fence line to SJ 2901 0302, continuing in a general WNW direction along a field edge to where it meets FP6 at SJ 2883 0310, Point C on the Order Map, approximately 340m with a width of 2m throughout  
**AND** commencing from SJ 2874 0301, Point D on the Order Map, and then running along an unsealed track in a general NE direction to SJ 2888 0318, continuing in a general northerly, then NNE direction, across a culvert at SJ 2889 0326, to meet the continuation of FP6 at SJ 2891 0332, Point E on the Order Map, approximately 370m, with a width of 2m throughout.

Shropshire Council certify that the Order became operative on 10th June 2025 but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2026 make an application to the High Court.
