

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 59 (PART) PARISH OF CLAVERLEY)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024.**

The above named order made on 4th July 2024 by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A (2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will

Divert the full width of part of FP 59 leaving the County Road at Point A on the Order Map at grid reference SO 7873 9469, running in a general north westerly direction along a track then turning in a general westerly to run through 3 gates, alongside the two properties to point B on the Order map at grid reference SO 7857 9470. A distance of approximately 170 metres onto a line leaving the County Road at Point C on the Order Map at grid reference SO 7866 786666 then running in a NNW direction over a natural surface, along the eastern bank of the stream then crossing a footbridge at grid reference SO 78669467 and continuing in a generally WNW direction to Point B on the Order Map at grid reference SO 78579470. A distance of approximately 102 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout its length.

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
